September 2024 Prayer Points for Gary and Mary Reid



Since 2005 Gary and Mary Reid and their family have worked with and lived amongst the Maasai tribe living in a rural area called Olkinyei (pronounced Ol -Kin- yay!) making their home at PCEA Acacia Grove Mission, near to the Maasai Mara National Reserve in Kenya, and, in the following years, have worked with Maasai high up in the hills in Siana. Churches have been established within Olkinyei and Siana and lives have changed as the people trusted in Jesus as their Saviour.

Children returning to school Two government primary schools and a secondary school are sponsored by PCEA. Last year God enabled the building of nursery classrooms in both Olkinyei and Siana. Remember all the children who are returning to school. Education is important in this rural area as it helps children develop opportunities and helps protect them from being exploited (e.g. from child labour or early child marriage).

Safety Many of the children walk to school. Sometimes they can meet wild animals on their journey. Please pray that our LORD will continue to protect them. Give thanks for the dirt road in the hills for ease of movement, ensuring that the wild animals are more easily noticed.

Give thanks for God's provision of play parks!

Over the last number of years, God has provided four colourful play parks for the local children to use and have lots of fun. How we thank God for His provision!
