Volker & JinHyeog Glissmann



The Glissmanns have been in Malawi since 2010. Volker was involved from 2010-2018 with TEEM and is now working remotely for the Theological Education by Extension College (TEEC) in South Africa while based in Blantyre. JinHyeog works as a full-time music teacher at a primary school in Blantyre.


Volker was born in Germany and JinHyeog in South Korea. They served with Operation Mobilisation in Russia from 1997 to 2000. Out of this experience they developed a strong desire to continue to serve Christ's church. JinHyeog was privileged to serve in their home congregation Harmony Hill Presbyterian Lisburn as Music Director for a few years before the family left for Malawi. Volker and JinHyeog have three children; their daughter works in England, their older son studies in the UK while the youngest is at school in Blantyre.


Pray for the people of Malawi, that they continue to have peace and joy
