November 2024 Prayer Points Csaba & Ilona Veres



In January 2024, Csaba and Ilona Veres moved to Hungary at the invitation of the Hungarian Reformed Church to work in a village church plant in Hajdúböszörmény. They previously lived and worked in Romania as global mission workers for many years.

The Hajduboszormeny mother church began this church plant one year before and hold bi-weekly services and community work including an afterschool program and mothers and babies' group from a rented property in the village. Csaba and Ilona have been building relationships and holding weekly meetings and other events to tell those who live there about the good news of Jesus.

Ilona grew up in Sloan Street Presbyterian Church, Lisburn and Csaba in the Hungarian Reformed Church in his hometown of Zalau. They have two daughters.

Please pray during the month of November for the Veres family, particularly:

- Pray for a permanent location for weekly services, Bible studies and small groups, and for the necessary funding for this. They currently have use of a property in the centre of the village and can use the village hall from time to time.
- Give thanks for the Light Party and youth night held at the end of October. Pray that the seeds of the word of God will bear fruit in the lives of those who attended.
- Give thanks for each family that have been connected with. Please join in praying that they would respond to the gospel and follow Jesus.
